Facts at a Glance

Volunteer Hours

During 2009, volunteers gave **9555 hours of service** to DCM and its ministries. These hours are **valued at \$118,806.00**.

Volunteers supported DCM by:

- Serving meals at Hagar's House
- Holding financial management sessions
- Assisting in the offices and tech center
- Stocking the food pantry
- Helping children with homework
- Serving on family interview teams
- Helping with fundraising, child care, and building and yard maintenance.

Volunteer hours for professional services such as legal work and computer repair are valued at their market rate. All other volunteer hours are valued at \$12 per hour.

In-Kind Donations

In-kind donations during 2009 are valued at **\$173,391.27**.

Many organizations, groups, and individuals generously provided items including:

- Furniture and appliances
- Cleaning supplies and toiletries
- Toys and gifts for clients
- Household items such as linens and toiletries
- Decorations and other items for events
- Food
